COSTS

Tuition & Living Cost

Tuition is determined by the institution and programme. Indicative annual ranges are:

PROGRAMME AREA	APPROXIMATE ANNUAL TUITION
Business and social sciences	US\$3,000 – \$5,000
Computer Science and Engineering	US\$3,500 – \$6,000
Medicine	US\$4,000 – \$8,000
Dentistry	US\$4,500 – \$8,000
Master's programmes	US\$3,000 – \$6,000

Certain specialist or premium programmes may charge more. Students should also check application, recognition, registration, insurance and laboratory fees.

Tuition should be paid only to the university's verified account after the student has received appropriate admission documentation.

WHAT YOU NEED

Entry Requirements

Requirements vary between universities and programmes.

| Bachelor's programmes

Applicants normally need:

- ✓ Complete secondary-school certificate
- ✓ Academic transcripts
- ✓ Valid passport
- ✓ Passport photograph
- ✓ Proof of English-language ability
- ✓ Completed application
- ✓ Video interview, where required
- ✓ Certified Georgian translations
- ✓ Recognition of previous education

| Master's programmes

Applicants generally need:

- ✓ Recognised bachelor's degree
- ✓ Academic transcript
- ✓ Valid passport
- ✓ CV and motivation letter
- ✓ Proof of English proficiency
- ✓ Academic or professional references, where requested
- ✓ Interview or entrance assessment

| Medicine and Dentistry

Applicants usually need:

- ✓ Secondary-school completion certificate
- ✓ Biology and Chemistry in their previous studies
- ✓ Evidence of English proficiency
- ✓ Online interview or university assessment
- ✓ Valid passport and translated educational documents

Some institutions may also examine Physics or Mathematics results.

LANGUAGE

Language Requirement

English-taught programmes commonly require approximately B2-level English, but the form of evidence varies. A university may accept:

- ✓ IELTS or TOEFL
- ✓ Cambridge English qualifications
- ✓ Previous education completed in English
- ✓ A medium-of-instruction certificate
- ✓ The university's own interview or language test

Applicants should confirm whether external English certification is required before submitting an application.

VISA ROUTE

Student Visa Process

Visa requirements depend on the student's nationality and existing residence status.

Students who require a visa normally apply for a D3 immigration visa for study purposes. Common supporting documents may include:

- ✓ Valid passport
- ✓ University admission or enrolment evidence
- ✓ Ministry or education-authority approval where applicable
- ✓ Proof of tuition payment
- ✓ Evidence of sufficient funds
- ✓ Accommodation details
- ✓ Health or travel insurance
- ✓ Passport photograph
- ✓ Evidence of the purpose and duration of study

Some nationalities may enter Georgia without a visa for a specified period, but visa-free entry should not be confused with long-term student residence. Students should verify their individual position through official channels.
