- ✓ Valid passport
- ✓ School or university certificates
- ✓ Academic transcripts
- ✓ Proof of English proficiency, such as IELTS, TOEFL or another accepted test
- ✓ Personal statement or statement of purpose
- ✓ Letters of recommendation
- ✓ CV or résumé for postgraduate applications
- ✓ Portfolio for art, architecture or design programmes
- ✓ GRE, GMAT, SAT or ACT results when required
- ✓ Evidence of sufficient financial resources

VISA ROUTE

Student Visa Process

- 1 Apply to an institution certified by the Student and Exchange Visitor Program.
- 2 Receive an admission offer.
- 3 Provide the institution with the required financial evidence.
- 4 Receive Form I-20.
- 5 Pay the I-901 SEVIS fee.
- 6 Complete the student-visa application.
- 7 Arrange and attend the visa interview, if required.
- 8 Prepare financial, academic and supporting documents.
- 9 Travel to the United States within the permitted entry period.
